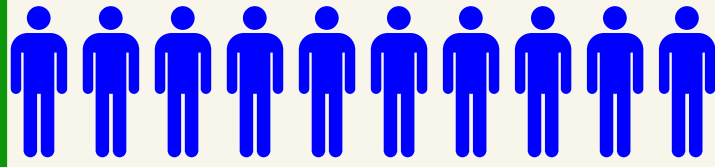

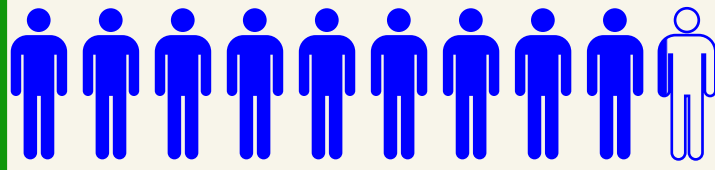

FIVE-YEAR SURVIVAL



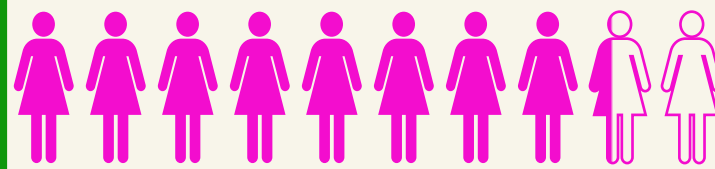

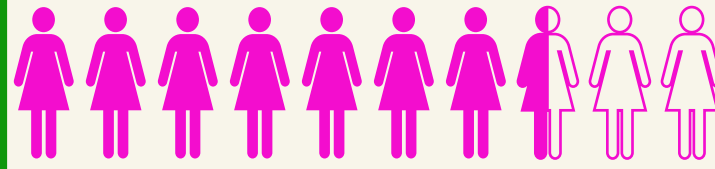

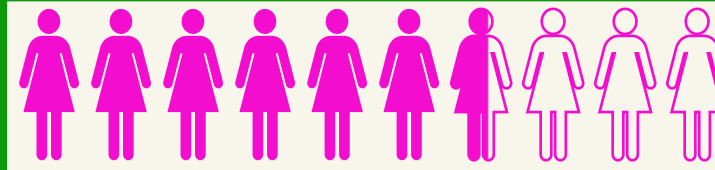

FOR MEN AND WOMEN RESIDING IN NORTHERN IRELAND
BUT THERE IS STILL ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT**



STOMACH CANCER FIVE-YEAR SURVIVAL STILL ONLY 18.0%



PANCREATIC CANCER FIVE-YEAR SURVIVAL STILL ONLY 5.0%



OESOPHAGEAL CANCER FIVE-YEAR SURVIVAL STILL ONLY 16.7%
