



QUB Admission Requirements Egypt

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ The Certificate of General Secondary Education with 80% plus successful completion of a recognised Foundation programme.
- ▶ Applicants who have successfully completed at least one year of university study in Egypt with good grades will be considered on a case by case basis.
- ▶ A Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Egyptian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree from a recognised University with a minimum of 75% or CGPA of 3.0/4.0, depending on the institutional grading system.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree from a recognised University with a minimum of 70% or 2.8/4.0, depending on the institutional grading system.
