



QUB Admission Requirements Ghana

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ Applicants with the West African Examinations Council (WAEC) Senior Secondary School Certificate will be required to complete a Foundation Programme.
- ▶ Applicants holding a Ghanaian Higher National Diploma may be considered for entry to the first year of undergraduate courses with a CGPA of 3.0 (upper credit) and above
- ▶ Applicants who have successfully completed the first year of a Ghanaian University degree in a relevant subject will be considered for admission to the first year of undergraduate degree programmes.
- ▶ 3 UK A Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB). [Information on required grades.](#)

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Ghanaian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree from a recognised HE Institution (Second Class Honours, Upper Division)

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree from a recognised HE Institution (Second Class Honours, Lower Division)

English Language Requirements:

- ▶ WASSCE with a minimum of C6 accepted for most programmes.
