



QUB Admission Requirements Iraq

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ Completion of Year 12 (Sixth Form Baccalaureate) with good grades, plus a recognised Foundation Programme.
- ▶ 3 UK A-levels
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma
- ▶ Applicants who have undertaken at least one year of study at an Iraqi university with good grades in relevant subjects may be considered for Stage One entry.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Iraqi qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A Bachelor degree from a recognised institution with an overall grade of 75 - 80%, depending on the institution attended.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A Bachelor degree from a recognised institution with an overall grade of 70 - 75%, depending on the institution attended.
