

QUB Admission Requirements Kenya



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ Kenyan students who complete UK A Levels should meet the usual UK A level undergraduate entry requirements as indicated in our Course Finder.
- ▶ Applicants with the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) will normally be required to successfully complete a recognised Foundation programme.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB). [Information on required grades](#).

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Kenyan qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree with 2.1 or Second-Class Honours, Upper Division (60-69%)

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree with 2.2 or Second-Class Honours, Lower Division (50-59%)

English Language Requirements:

- ▶ WASSCE with a minimum of C6 accepted for most programmes.
