

QUB Admission Requirements Kuwait



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ The Shahadat-al-thanawia-al-a'ama (General Secondary School Certificate) with a score of 80% plus a recognised Foundation programme.
- ▶ The American High School Diploma with a CGPA of 3.2/4.0 plus a recognised Foundation programme (if no APs or SAT IIs are taken).
- ▶ Applicants who have successfully completed the first year of a Kuwaiti University degree with good grades in relevant subjects may be considered for admission to the first year of an undergraduate programme.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Kuwaiti qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A Bachelor degree from a recognised university with grade B or 3.0/4 or 3.75/5 or 'Very Good'.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A Bachelor degree from a recognised university with grade B- or 2.67/4 or 3.3/5 or 'Good'.
