



QUB Admission Requirements

Libya

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ The Secondary Education Certificate with good grades, plus a recognised Foundation programme.
- ▶ Applicants who have completed the first year of a Bachelor degree at a recognised Libyan university with good grades in relevant subjects will be considered for admission to the first year of undergraduate degree programmes.
- ▶ 3 UK A Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Libyan qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A four-year Bachelor degree from a recognised Libyan university with a grade of 70%.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A four-year Bachelor degree from a recognised Libyan university with a grade of 65%.
