

QUB Admission Requirements Mexico



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ A Bachillerato (completed 12 years of education) with an average mark of 7/10 or 70% plus a recognised Foundation programme with good grades.
- ▶ Successfully completed the first year of a Mexican University degree (Licenciado) with good grades in relevant subjects.
- ▶ Students who have not completed a year at university level will be expected to undertake a foundation or bridging programme, for example the INTO Queen's [International Foundation Programme](#), before they can be admitted to an undergraduate degree programme.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Mexican qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A four-year Licenciado or Professional Title with 8.0 (bien).

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A four-year Licenciado or Professional Title with 7.0 (suficiente).
