

QUB Admission Requirements Oman



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ The Thanawijah Amma (Secondary School Leaving Certificate) plus a recognised Foundation Programme, such as those offered by [INTO Queen's](#), may be acceptable in lieu of A-levels.
- ▶ American High School Diploma plus a recognised Foundation Programme (if no APs or SAT IIs are taken).
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma
- ▶ Students who have completed one or two years of university study may be eligible for undergraduate admission, if relevant subjects have been studied and strong grades achieved.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable qualifications from Oman are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A four-year Bachelor degree from a recognised university with a minimum GPA of 3.0/4.0.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A four-year Bachelor degree from a recognised university with a minimum GPA of 2.8/4.0.
