



# QUB Admission Requirements Pakistan

## Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ Intermediate/Higher Education Secondary School Examinations (Year 12) with good grades plus a recognised Foundation programme.
- ▶ Completion of a two or three-year Bachelor degree with a first division (60%+).
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB).

## Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Pakistani qualifications are as follows:

### UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A 4-year undergraduate degree from an HEC recognised institution with a minimum of 70% or GPA 3.0/4.
- ▶ A 2 or 3-year Bachelor degree with a minimum of 60% plus a Masters degree with 70% may be considered on an individual basis.

### UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A 4-year undergraduate degree from an HEC recognised institution with a minimum of 60% or GPA 2.8/4.
- ▶ A 2 or 3-year Bachelor degree with a minimum of 55% plus a Masters degree with 60% may be considered on an individual basis.

## English Language Requirements:

- ▶ Many iGCSE syllabi and GCE O-Level in English language are accepted
