



QUB Admission Requirements South Africa

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ Graduates from the National Senior Certificate should have a minimum requirement of five subjects, four of which must be at Grade 6 or higher, including any required subjects at Grade 6 (or Grade 7 where an A is required).
- ▶ Applicants who have completed their Senior Certificate (with matriculation endorsement) and obtained Higher grade passes in five or more subjects (with a minimum of three Bs and two Cs) may be considered for admission to undergraduate degree programmes. Grades AAABB - BBBB in higher grade subjects are normally required.
- ▶ 3 UK A Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB). [Information on required grades.](#)

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable South African qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ Professional Bachelor or Bachelor Honours degree awarded Second Class Division 1.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ Professional Bachelor or Bachelor Honours degree awarded Second Class Division 2.
