

QUB Admission Requirements Taiwan



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ The Taiwanese Senior High School Certificate with good grades, plus a recognised Foundation Programme.
- ▶ Applicants who have undertaken at least one year of study at a Taiwanese university with good grades in relevant subjects may be considered for Stage One entry.
- ▶ 3 UK A Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Taiwanese qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree from a recognised National or Private university with a grade of 75% or GPA 3.25/4.0.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree from a recognised National or Private university with a grade of 70% or GPA 2.75/4.0.
