



QUB Admission Requirements Zimbabwe

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ 3 Zimbabwean A-Levels. The grades required vary from AAA to BBB depending on the programme.
- ▶ 3 UK A-Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Zimbabwean qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A good Bachelor Honours degree from a recognised institution with grades of 2:1, 65%, B++ or above.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A good Bachelor Honours degree from a recognised institution with grades of 2:2, 60-64%, B+ or above.

English Language Requirements:
