

Undergraduate requirements – US Curriculum

UK A-level	Entry Equivalences
AAA	Three AP tests at scores of 555 OR Three SAT subject tests at scores of 700, 700, 700 or a combination of the two.
AAB	Three AP tests at scores of 554 OR Three SAT subject tests at scores of 700, 700, 650 or a combination of the two.
ABB	Three AP tests at scores of 544 OR Three SAT subject tests at scores of 700, 650, 650 or a combination of the two.
BBB	Three AP tests at scores of 444 OR Three SAT subject tests at scores of 650, 650, 650 or a combination of the two.
BBC	Three AP tests at scores of 443 OR Three SAT subject tests at scores of 650, 650, 600 or a combination of the two.

Subject-specific requirements must be met.

A combination of qualifications is acceptable, for example 2 AP tests and the combined ACT test is acceptable, and 3 SAT Subject Tests is also acceptable. An honours or college level course may also be accepted in place of one AP or SAT subject test.

The University is aware that some standardized tests may have been cancelled due to the pandemic. Applicants who are impacted by this should notify the Admissions and Access Service.



Undergraduate requirements – US Grade Comparability

UK A-level Grade	A	B	C
Advanced Placement (AP)	5	4	3
SAT II Subject Test	700	650	600
SAT 1	1350 (min 700, 650)	1290 (min 620, 650)	1250 (min 620, 620)
ACT	28	27	26
Honors/College Course	A+	B+	C+

Example – where Grade B is required at A-level:

Honours/College level class with minimum* Grade B+ or SAT 1 test with a minimum* of 1290 (with a minimum of 620 in Mathematics and 650 in Evidence-Based Reading and Writing), or ACT with 27, may be considered in lieu of one AP or SAT Subject test (excludes courses which require AAA)

**A higher score may be required depending on scores achieved in AP/SAT Subject tests.
Subjects cannot be counted twice.*
