



QUB Admission Requirements Yemen

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ Successful completion of the Shahadat Al-Thawayya Al-Aama (General Secondary Education Certificate) with 80%, plus successful completion of a recognised Foundation Programme.
- ▶ 3 UK A Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable qualifications from Yemen are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ Masters degree with Classification of 'Very Good'.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ Masters degree with Classification of 'Good'.
