International applicants who pay the £400 course deposit and subsequently meet the academic/English Language condition(s) will normally also have to fulfil the University's requirement for a total deposit payment of £2,500 to be paid before a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) can be issued for visa purposes.
