He is author of more than a dozen award-winning books including *Journey into Islam: The Crisis of Globalization* (2007), *Journey into America: The Challenge of Islam* (2010), and *The Thistle and the Drone: How America's War on Terror Became a Global War on Tribal Islam* (2013), all published by Brookings. His *Journey into Europe: Islam, Immigration and Identity* will be published in 2018 and, like the other books in the *Journeys* series, has been made into a documentary film. Ahmed has taught at Harvard and Princeton and was Senior Fellow at Brookings. Named by the BBC as 'the world's leading authority on contemporary Islam', his work as playwright and poet has been broadcast and performed around the globe.
