Terms, Conditions and Exclusions

Accommodation Award Details

The Accommodation Award available covers private, single en-suite rooms in Queen's University Accommodation only. The award cannot be used to obtain off-campus housing.

Students offered the International Accommodation Award must:

1. Accept the scholarship by deadline of the 30th June. The Faculty Office reserves the right to withdraw the offer of a scholarship if it is not accepted by the given deadline.

2. Meet any conditions attached to your academic offer.

3. Register on your academic course by the given start date, as specified in your confirmation email. Scholarships may not be deferred to the following academic year.

4. Be registered as a full-time student and be classified as overseas for fee purposes.

5. Inform the Faculty Office of any other scholarships/sponsorship currently held, or awarded at a later date. Our scholarship may be adjusted or withdrawn if other sources of funding have been awarded-such as the Queen's Vice Chancellor's Scholarship. Our scholarship is not available as a cash alternative. This award CAN be used in conjunction with the International Office Scholarship however.

7. Pay all outstanding tuition fees by University deadlines.

8. Have means to cover their living costs for subsequent years of study as the Accommodation Award will only be offered for year 1. UKVI requires students to have £1,015 for each month of your course to cover living costs.

Exclusions:

The award is available to students undertaking QUB PhD study only and the following degrees are excluded from this award:

- External PhD programmes where students only undertake part of their research at Queen's University.
- Higher Doctorates Doctor of Divinity (DD), Doctor of Laws (LLD), Doctor of Letters (DLitt), Doctor of Science (DSc), Doctor of Science (Economics) (DSc(Econ)), Doctor of Science, (Education) (DSc(Ed)) and Doctor of Social Science (DSSc)
- PhD programmes by Published Works
- Juris Doctorate Students (JD)

Students must commence their PhD programme in 2017. Applications will not be considered from existing QUB PhD students or those seeking to commence their studies in 2018 or beyond.
