

CED Support for eLearning

The Centre of Educational Development provides training and advice on good practice for using technology to enhance learning, teaching and assessment. Examples of CED's support for elearning include:

- **eLearning Resources**
where the Centre advises on the creation of online learning resources
- **Queen's Online**
where the Centre can provide advice on best practice in developing resources for QOL and in exploiting its other features which include online assessment, wikis and discussion forums
- **Using Technologies in Teaching and Learning**
where the Centre can provide advice on best practice in using technologies within and beyond the classroom to facilitate learners' engagement with their subject material and promote deeper learning. This includes question design for lecture voting and online assessment, the "flipped classroom" approach.
- **Similarity checking software (TurnitinUK).**
where the Centre can advise on the use of the software to help educate students about plagiarism
- **Electronic Marking and Feedback**
where the Centre can advise on the use of GradeMark, screencast and voice recording software for providing electronic feedback.
- **Distance Learning**
where the Centre can provide advice on good practice in designing, developing and delivering distance learning courses
