

Postgraduate Certificate in Higher Education Teaching – Overview

The Postgraduate Certificate in Higher Education Teaching (PGCHET) is primarily aimed at new academic staff on probation and provides a formal qualification in teaching and learning in higher education and is accredited by the Higher Education Academy.

On successful completion of the course, which is made up of three modules (20 CATS points each) and completion of associated coursework, graduates are eligible to become a Fellow of the Academy (on application).
