Annual Module and Programme Review provides a formal opportunity for staff to reflect on the most recent delivery of the module / programme. The Academic Affairs division of the Directorate for Academic and Student Affairs deals with the formal regulatory aspects of Module / Programme Review. The Centre for Educational Development can support any focus on enhancement during this process. In addition, if development needs are identified during the course of the Module / Programme Review then the Centre can support work in this area.
