Queen's Online – Using the Assignment tool (student view)


The purpose of this document is to provide an overview of the Assignment tool within Queen's Online. This is the facility within Queen's Online through which you can submit assignments. Your module tutor will inform you if they expect you to submit your work using Queen's Online.

## To access the Assignment tool

1. On the Queen's Online Home page - <a href="www.qub.ac.uk/qol">www.qub.ac.uk/qol</a> - select the current Academic Year. In the example below, 2012/13:




2. Select the correct module. To identify the correct module hover the mouse over the module code. In this example the module is **Learning & Teaching Test Module**.




3. This displays the Module home page. Click on **Assignment** in the left-hand panel.



4. This displays any current assignments for the module. **Open** the relevant assignment.



This displays details of the assignment.



## **Notes**

The tutor may provide further information about the assignment (for example, **1** above indicates that the tutor has provided a Word document).


Your tutor will inform you as to 1) whether or not your assignment will be viewed with your name on it or be anonymous to the tutor; 2) whether you will be able to see the marks subsequent to submission.

5. When ready to **submit your work**: **Browse** for your assignment file and click **Upload** (2 above).

Please note there is a limit of 100 Mb for each submission. If you have several components to your work you can zip them to create a single file for submission.

6. In the screen shot shown below you can see that a student has submitted their work as a PDF (the tutor will specify the file formats they will accept). **Once submitted,** you still have the option to **delete** the submission and re-submit (until the deadline).



## Please note:

If the submission is after the deadline the tutor can clearly see late submissions in their view of the submitted work.

## Feedback (please note this is only an example - your tutors may use the assignment tool differently)

In this example when the student subsequently opened the assignment tool, they are shown the tutor's interim (in this case) feedback plus a mark.
