Inter-Library Loans

Electronic delivery of British Library articles

The British Library delivers scanned print articles directly to your PC via Secure Electronic Delivery (SED).

- SED emails will arrive in your intray from *Sender: noreply@bldss.bl.uk*
- The document must be viewed within **30 days** of despatch by British Library after which it will be deleted. Even if saved to your PC, it will only remain viewable during this period
- You can **open** and **print** the document only once
- You cannot forward the document after you have opened it
- You cannot store the document on your hard drive unless you have paid a copyright fee (you can then store it for 3 years to refer to but still print it only once)

Software Requirements

A FileOpen plug-in is required to download SED documents. To install it go to <http://plugin.fileopen.com>

Once you have installed FileOpen, please download the BL test document from <http://fileopen.bl.uk> before you place an ILL request. If the test document appears, the plug-in is correctly installed and you can continue to order SED documents.

WIFI Service

It is not advisable to use the QUB Wireless Laptop Service to open and download SED documents as it is not possible to offer direct access to printing facilities from a service which is distributed over numerous locations.
