## MS 50 Kennedy Collection

#### About the collection:

A small collection of facsimile items and photographs relating to President John F. Kennedy's Presidential visit to Ireland in June 1963, five months before his assassination on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 1963.

The collection includes a poem transcribed on the reverse of an itinerary for a state visit to Italy in July 1963, a speech given before the Irish Parliament on 28<sup>th</sup> June 1963 and photographs of John F. Kennedy with well-wishers in County Wexford, Cork and Galway.

The facsimiles and photographs were deposited with Queen's University, Belfast in 2009 by the <u>John F. Kennedy</u> <u>Presidential Library and Museum, Boston</u> to be exhibited in support of a memorial lecture given by Dan Fenn, former Staff Assistant to President Kennedy, in the Great Hall on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2009.
