House wine

Art Indomita Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

Zingy, zesty and rich with a delicious mouth-watering finish

Art Indomita Merlot, Chile

Smooth soft style bursting with plummy fruits and lots of spice on the finish

Vina Arroba Tempranillo Rose, Spain

Medium sweet with mountains of red berry fruits. It's a real crowd pleaser

Sparkling Wine

Prosecco Riondo Frizzante, Italy

Frizzante is lightly sparkling with a refreshing apple and floral finish

Marques de la Concordia Vintage Cava Brut, Spain

Dry bottle fermentation method sparkling from Spain's Penedes region. This wine is phenomenal value for money, fine bubbles with complex yeasty notes and a crisp fruit filled finish

Prosecco Sartori Erfo, Italy

Off dry bubbly with delicate pear aromas & peachy overtones

Champagne

Ayala NV Brut Majeur, France

Bollinger's baby sister from just across the road. The chardonnay reveals all the purity and elegance, enhanced by Pinot Noir and Meunier's delivering soft red fruits

Bollinger NV Special Cuvee, France

A majority of reserve wines make up this blend, which have been aged in magnums for 5-15 years. Depth and subtlety, pure class in a glass

White wine

Coldridge Estate Chardonnay, Australia

Creamy and tropical on the nose with pear, peach and mango aromas

Tempus Two "Silver Series" Pinot Gris, Australia

Everyone's favourite, this light and crisp wine delivers Granny Smith Apple Flavours with a refreshingly dry finish

Moloko Bay Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa

With all the hallmarks of textbook Sauvignon, including gooseberry and freshly cut spring grass

Ropiteau "Les Plants Noble" Chardonnay, France

The bouquet of this French Chardonnay releases a blend of citrus and flower aromas (hawthorn, jasmine). Well-rounded and soft finish

Salmon Club Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand

This wine has crisp acidity with the distinctive bouquet and herbaceous flavours of citrus fruit

Sand Boy "Rias Baixas" Albarino, Spain

An impressive example of Spain's iconic white varieties, from the sea swept Rías Baixas region. The juicy fruit is lifted by delicious freshness, with notes of stone fruit and minerality

Joseph Drouhin "Laforet" Bourgogne Chardonnay, France

Joseph Drouhin is one of Burgundy's finest producers and this Chardonnay is a true expression of the terroir and vintage. The vineyards for this stunning Cote d'Or produce a steely fruit driven wine with elegance and great balance

Langlois Chateau Sancerre Sancerre, France

is arguably the best example for Sauvignon Blanc in the world. This wine has everything, citrus fruits (lemon and lime), flowers (mostly white ones), and slightly green aromas (cut grass and bell pepper)

Red wine

Camina Cabernet Sauvignon, Spain

Full Bodied aromas of blackcurrant leaf, bell pepper, mint and roasted meat are matched by supple tannins

Coldridge Estate Shiraz, Australia

Spicy and warm with black fruit flavours. Perfect with red meat dishes

Cigar Box "Old Vine" Mendoza Malbec, Argentina

Intense purplish red colour. Sweet, spicy and intense aromas, with notes of red fruits and herbs

Vega Douro Tinto, Portugal

Vega eminates from the steep terraced vineyards of the Douro Valley. It is rich with plum, cherry and mineral elements and complex with a firm grip of tannins, typical of the region

Valpolicella Ripasso, Aristrocratico, Italy

Deep and concentrated with an intense bouquet of ripe fruit, sweet cherry and toasted oak. Black cherry on the palate leads to a long, complex and well-integrated finish

Marques de Caceres Rioja Crianza, Spain

Great balance between the spicy aromas of the barrel and the fruity character of the Tempranillo

Hellbent Stellenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon, South Africa

Former Ulster & South Africa rugby star Louis Ludik as linked up with Neethslinghof estate to produce this Cabernet Sauvignon. It is bouncing with dark black fruits, chocolate and a hint of vanilla

Joseph Drouhin Bourgogne Pinot Noir, France

Pinot Noir at its best, the wine begins by expressing pretty floral notes of violet, rose, iris, with a typical peppery note which then evolves into red fruits
