Eligibility

To be eligible you must:

- FT UG student (Inc Integrated Masters degrees e.g. MSci or MEng)
- be a year 1, 2 or a penultimate year student (**Current Final year students are not eligible to apply**)
- be 'ordinarily' a resident of Northern Ireland and qualify for NI Fee status
- not previously received an International Mobility Grant for a study or work placement abroad or participated on a funded international opportunity through Queen's Global Opportunities Team e.g. Queen's Global Leadership Programme, Utrecht Summer School

In addition, applicants must meet at least one of the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a participant on the Queen's Pathways Programme
- be a participant on the Queen's Senior Academy Programme
- have an annual household income of £25,000 or less
- Care Experienced: Queen's University define care experienced as any student who has been or is currently in care or from a looked after background for period of three months or more at any age



