Eligibility

To be eligible you must:

- be a full-time degree registered undergraduate Queen's student (Including integrated Masters degrees e.g. MSci or MEng)
- be a year 1, 2 or a penultimate year student (Final year students are not eligible to apply)
- be a resident of Northern Ireland and qualify for fees at "Home Student" status.

In addition, applicants must meet at least one of the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a participant on the Queen's Pathways Programme.
- be a participant on the Queen's Senior Academy Programme.
- have an annual household income of £25,000 or less.
- you were in the care of a Health and Social Care Trust or Local Authority for three months or more from the age of 14 years.



- University of North Carolina Chapel Hill or Wilmington campus
- Westminster College



- 5 Clinton Scholarships available- Up to £12,000 per semester
- Students spending the full year can potentially receive a tuition fee waiver (dependant on funding source)

- Strand 1:The Clinton Scholarships (Strand 1)- USA Study Exchanges
 - Up to £12,000 to cover:
 - Flights
 - Accommodation
 - Visa
 - Medical insurance
 - Day to day costs
 - If you do not get a scholarship there is still funding approx. £380 per month

Application Tips
