Why are we offering these opportunities?

- Launched in April 2023
- Ensure International mobility is more accessible for local students
- Develop Queen's students as Global Citizens- Queen's Strategy 2030
- Student Employability from a Global Perspective

Eligibility

To be eligible you must:

- FT UG student (Inc Integrated Masters degrees e.g. MSci or MEng)
- be a year 1, 2 or a penultimate year student (**Current Final year students are not eligible to apply**)
- be 'ordinarily' a resident of Northern Ireland and qualify for NI Fee status
- not previously received an International Mobility Grant for a study or work placement abroad or participated on a funded international opportunity through Queen's Global Opportunities Team e.g. Queen's Global Leadership Programme, Utrecht Summer School

In addition, applicants must meet at least one of the following eligibility criteria:

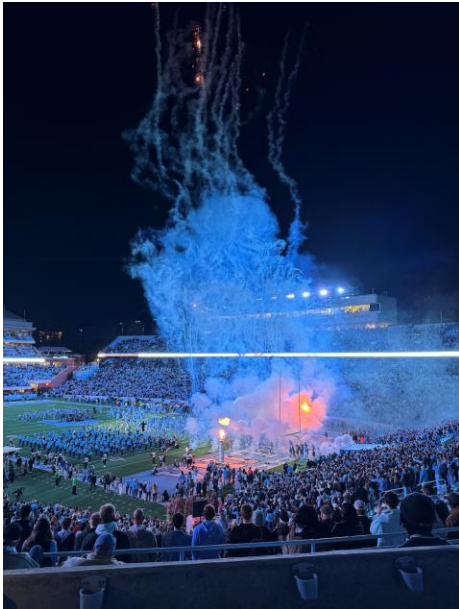
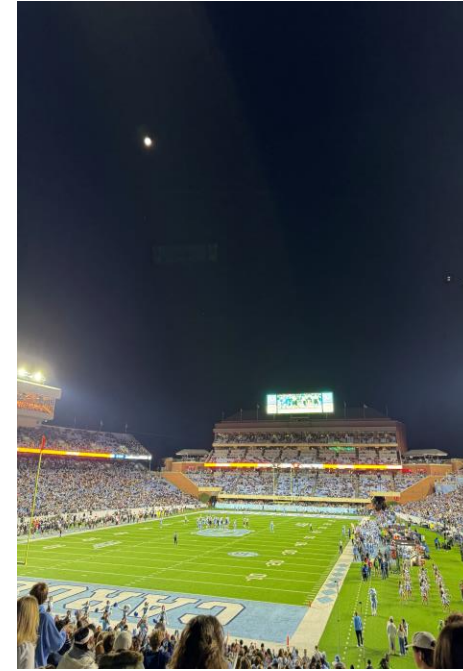
- Be a participant on the Queen's Pathways Programme
- be a participant on the Queen's Senior Academy Programme
- have an annual household income of £25,000 or less
- Care Experienced: Queen's University define care experienced as any student who has been or is currently in care or from a looked after background for period of three months or more at any age

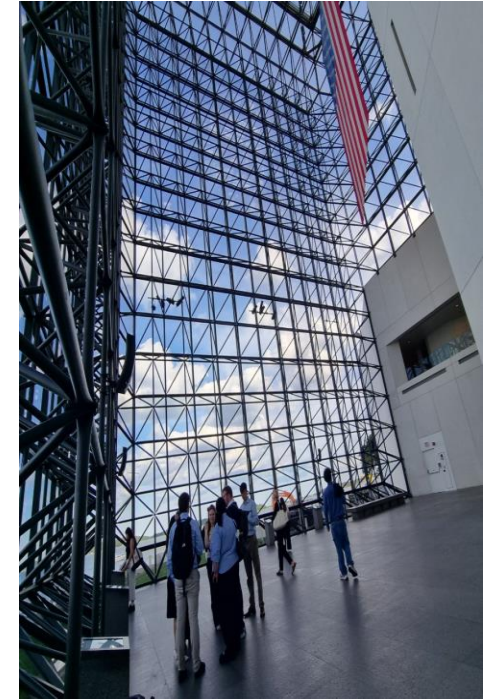

- Spend 1 semester or 1 academic year studying at one of the below institutions:

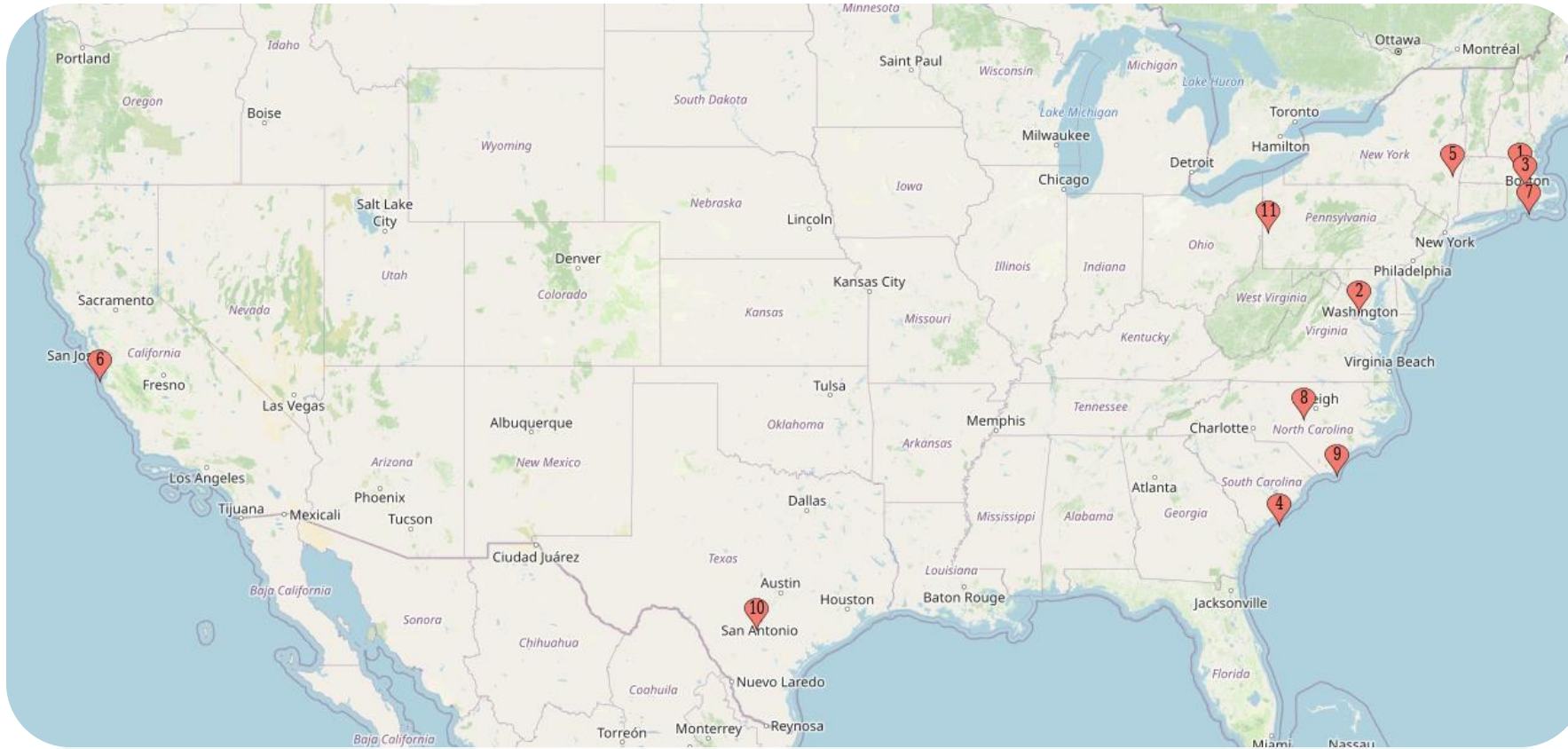
USA Partners

- American University
 - Boston College
 - College of Charleston
 - Minnesota State University
 - University of California Santa Cruz
 - University of Massachusetts – Dartmouth or Lowell campus
 - University of North Carolina – Chapel Hill or Wilmington campus
 - University of Texas at San Antonio
 - Westminster College
- **5 Clinton Scholarships available- Up to £12,000 per semester**
 - Students spending the full year can potentially receive a tuition fee waiver (dependant on funding source)

Costs

- Strand 1: The Clinton Scholarships (Strand 1) - USA Study Exchanges
 - Up to £12,000 per semester to cover:
 - Flights
 - Accommodation
 - Visa
 - Medical insurance
 - Day to day costs
 - If you do not get a scholarship, there is still funding – approx. £420 per month
- Strand 2: The Clinton Career Insights Programme
 - Flights
 - Accommodation
 - Airport transfers & 7-day city travel card
 - Visa
 - Insurance
 - Breakfast and some additional meals



Application Tips

Both strands will involve a competitive application process, revolving around motivation, reflection and eligibility for the programme.

- Review the eligibility criteria
- Do your research
- Read each question attentively and in its entirety
- Ensure that your answer covers all aspects of the question
- Be mindful of the word count but use it
- Focus on your motivations and future plans
