# Eligibility

To be eligible you must:

- be a full-time degree registered undergraduate Queen's student (Including integrated Masters degrees e.g. MSci or MEng)
- be a year 1, 2 or a penultimate year student (**Final year students are not eligible to apply**)
- be a resident of Northern Ireland and qualify for fees at "Home Student" status.

In addition, applicants must **meet at least one** of the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a participant on the Queen's Pathways Programme.
- be a participant on the Queen's Senior Academy Programme.
- have an annual household income of £25,000 or less.
- Care Experienced: Queen's University define care experienced as any student who has been or is currently in care or from a looked after background for period of three months or more at any age.
