## **Study USA**

- 1 full academic year in a US college/ University
- Study Business and/or STEM related subjects
- NI/UK/EU full time undergraduate student of any discipline
- Students must apply in their 2<sup>nd</sup> Year
- The scholarship funding package (worth approximately £35,000) includes;

-Room and board for the academic year -A generous text book allowance

-One return flight to the US

- University fees are waived and accommodation is paid for by DfE. Students pay participation fee (£1,500), visas, travel/health insurance. If a student is in receipt of a maintenance grant this fee will be waived.

### **Washington Ireland Programme**

- 12-month Service & Leadership Programme:
  - Pre departure and preparation
  - 8-week Summer Internship in Washington DC or New York
  - Community Service & Advocacy upon returning home
- Open to all disciplines- UG and PG (Full time only)
- Live with host family in NY or DC
- Applicants must be born in the Republic of Ireland or Northern Ireland, or a citizen of Ireland or Northern Ireland, or regard Ireland or Northern Ireland as home.
- Approx. cost £1,250- WIP provides return flights, Accommodation, Visa processing fees and weekly stipend for travel costs. Applicants can apply for WIP Scholarship.

- Student covers- Programme fee of £100, \$160 J1 processing fee, Travel insurance to cover your belongings (optional) & Spending money.

2 Programmes- Undergraduate & Graduate

### J1 – 1 year Intern Visa (<u>All passports\*</u>)

- Apply if you have work/ placements already lined up prior to travel
- Responsibility is on the student / graduate to source their own placement prior to applying for this visa

### J-1 Irish Work and Travel Visa/ Graduate Visa

- Travel to U.S. without work lined up (120 day grace period)
- Irish Passport only
- Final year students and recent graduates (within 1 year of coursework end date).
- 1 year visa with a 30 day grace period at both ends

- Applications for 2024-25 open in February 2023
- · Financial Award for master's or doctoral degree at any accredited US university
- Financial award towards the first year of study:
  - Sickness and accident coverage
  - J-1 visa sponsorship
  - Support in the USA Access to a global alumni network
- Some Awards can offer:
  - Tuition fee waivers
  - Full-degree funding

#### Eligibility

- Be a UK citizen (Other citizens should contact Fulbright)
- Hold or expect to achieve a 2:1 degree classification

- Canadian Exchange Programme
- Camp Canada/ Camp America & BUNAC
- Mitacs Research Internship

### **University Exchange Programme**

✓ Undergrad✗ Postgrad✗ Graduates

- Spend 1 semester or 1 academic year studying at one of three institutions in Australia or Canada:
  - The University of Newcastle, New South Wales, Australia
  - Queen's University Kingston, Kingston, Ontario, Canada
  - University of Alberta, Edmonton, Canada
- Open to any full time Queen's University undergraduate student
- Turing funding potentially available
- NI/GB/EU students spending the full year can potentially receive a tuition fee waiver for the 2023-24 year. NI/GB/EU students spending only one semester will be required to pay the normal full tuition fees to QUB. International students spending either the full year or one semester will be required to pay the normal full tuition fee to QUB for the 2023-24 year. \*fee waiver is subject to approval

- 12-week Research Internship (Summer 2024)

- Competitive application process

#### Eligibility

- 18 years of age
