- Photo formats accepted are .jpg or .png.
- Ideal photo resolution should be 1240x1754pixels
- Email photos (2 maximum) to goglobal@qub.ac.uk with the subject "Photo Competition".

In your email include the following:

- First name, last name and student number
- Program (Exchange, Erasmus etc.)
- Location (university + city + country)
- Dates of your placement (Year, Semester 1, semester 2, summer)
- Include a short caption, around 50 words, to explain how your photo(s) represents student life in another part of the world.

Prizes

Photos will be evaluated based on quality, creativity and ability to capture the chosen theme, judges' decision is final.

2 winning entries will be selected and winners will receive a £50/€50 Ryanair gift voucher.
