- University fees are waived and accommodation is paid for by DfE. Students pay participation fee (£1,500), visas, travel/health insurance. If a student is in receipt of a maintenance grant this fee will be waived.

- Open to FT undergraduate students (Some subject restrictions)
- International Mobility Grant funding potentially available
- International students pay the normal full tuition fee to QUB for the year
