European Study Exchange Funding

International Mobility Grant funding **potentially** provides financial support for all full-time students

- Funding sources include UK Government (Turing Scheme), Irish Government and Queen's
- Funding paid to you by Global Opportunities in two instalments
- 2024-25 rates (per month)

Approx £420 or £360* depending on country. (Grouped by cost of living)

- Be prepared to cover some costs up front helps cover some costs

International Mobility Grant Funding examples

Example 1 (year-long placement)

- Student going to Germany on a 250-day placement (Group 2 country/Low cost of living)
 = £12 per day x 250 days = £3,000
- Student going to Germany on a 250-day placement from a disadvantaged background
 = £16 per day x 250 days = £4,000 + travel costs of up to £250 + visa costs = £4,250

Example 2 (semester long placement)

- Student going to Norway on a 100-day placement (Group 1 country/High cost of living) = £14 per day x 100 days = £1,450
- Student going to Norway on a 100-day placement from a disadvantaged background
 = £18 per day x 100 days = £1,800 + travel costs of up to £1,360 + visa costs = £3,160



- Placement can be anywhere in the world
- Open to any nationality
- Turing funding **potentially** available for full time students*
- Application for funding via School Placement Coordinator/ office
- Normal funding application closing date 8 weeks prior to placement


