Eligibility:

- Out of 24 places, 20 will be allocated to QUMS students. Leaving 4 places open to students from any School.
- Open to most levels of study – applicants must still be registered students during the tour (September 2016).
- Due to employer requirements applicants must have:
 - 300 UCAS points or equivalent
 - A minimum 60% average in university modules
- Priority may be given to students from under-represented QUMS courses

How to apply:

- There is a competitive application process through which applicants must demonstrate their motivation and commitment to working in this sector in London.
