Students encouraged to apply for roles by 19 April 2019. This may be extended for internships uploaded after March



Organisation completes selection matching process by 26 April 2019 (assistance may be available from QUB Careers Team)



Details of successful students confirmed by Organisation to QUB



Organisation signs <u>Health and Safety Agreement</u> and Student Placement Form of Indemnity and returns to QUB



At end of internship, eligible students submit completed Bursary Claim Form, signed by the Organisation, to <a href="QUB">QUB</a>



Student submits claim form and claim is processed by QUB
