Mark <u>not</u> capped and <u>no</u> resit charge.
FAL	Fail Alternative Assessment	The Student has failed this module having completed an Alternative Assessment.	Student offered the opportunity to take components of the module that were assessed on or after 16 th March again, for full marks, as an Alternative Assessment during the Supplementary Assessment period or in the original assessment form under normal conditions at the next available opportunity. Mark <u>not</u> capped and <u>no</u> resit charge.
FAS	Fail Assigned Mark	The Student has failed this module having been assigned a mark by the Schools Board of Examiners based upon previously completed work or continuous assessment. FSR	Fail Supplementary Regulations	The Student has failed one or more components of this module. Assessments were not impacted by Covid-19 but one or more assessments were completed on/ <u>after</u> 16 th March.	Student offered the opportunity to take components completed after 16 th March again, for full marks, as alternative assessments during the Supplementary Assessment period or in the original assessment form under normal conditions at the next available opportunity. For components completed before 16 th March the resit mark will be capped.
