Deadline to apply is **Friday 30 January 2026, 12noon.**

Eligibility is as follows:

- be a full-time degree registered undergraduate Queen's student (Including integrated Masters degrees e.g. MSci or MEng)
- be a year 1, 2 or a penultimate year student (Current Final year students are not eligible to apply)
- be 'ordinarily' a resident of Northern Ireland and qualify for NI Fee status
- not previously received an International Mobility Grant for a study or work placement abroad or participated on a funded international opportunity through Queen's Global Opportunities Team e.g. Queen's Global Leadership Programme, Utrecht Summer School.
