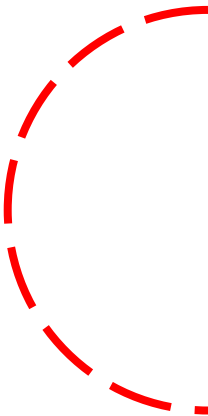

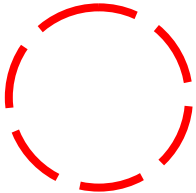

The Fostering Network



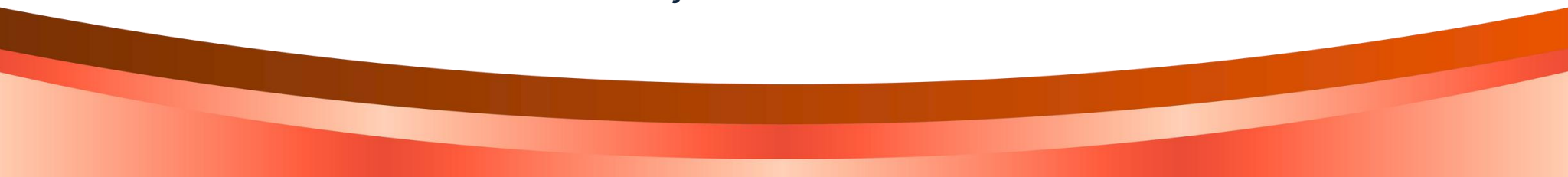
There is a box on your UCAS form to declare your experience of care
