



# **Summer Syllabus**

The summer syllabus will involve students working in groups to deliver a subject specific project in a particular or related subject they wish to study at University.

The project will focus on developing a range of transferrable skills, such as teamwork, research and communication skills.

The project will finish with a Showcase Event for participants to present their work and findings.

During and on completion of the project the participants will also deliver a reflective journal of their learning.



## **Tutor for Success**

All participants who complete over 85% of the programme are entitled to 30 hours subject specific tutoring.

# ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS



# **Eligibility: Section A**

## You must meet <u>all</u> of the following:

- In full-time education, currently studying in the first year of a two year, level 3 qualification e.g. A Level or equivalent (e.g. BTEC/OCR)
- Attending a Northern Ireland, non-selecting secondary school or college of further education
- You must have at least 5 GCSEs (or equivalent) at grades A\*-C, including \*English Language and \*Maths
- Neither of your parents have attended university nor obtained an undergraduate degree (or equivalent) in the UK, Ireland or abroad\*\*



# **Eligibility: Section B**

## You must meet **ONE** of the following:

- Have an annual household income of £19,203 or less
- You are eligible or are currently receiving free school meals (FSM) and/or Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA)
- You are the main carer for a family member or dependant
- Have a disability or an additional learning need
- Be a newcomer, refugee or asylum seeker\*
- You are care experienced or currently in the care of a Health and Social Care Trust\*\*


