

## **Admissions Update – May 2022**

### **2022 entry to Medicine admissions cycle**

As in the 2021 admissions cycle the Medical school has 236 places for home applicants. 787 home candidates attended for interview. The admissions team have provided early offers in late February and the majority of offers in early April 2022. As we receive replies to these offers the Medical school will continue to give as many offers as possible until the UCAS decision deadline (19th May 2022). All offers are given in rank order after interview.

As is our normal practice this rank order will also be used for offers should places become available in August/September. Offers after results day are given to those candidates who have fulfilled the entry requirements and are not holding a medical school places elsewhere. As vacancies become available, the next eligible applicant will be offered the place, so it will not be necessary for applicants to contact us. Please note that, at this stage, we cannot predict how many places, if any, may become available in August/September.

### **School of Nursing and Midwifery admissions update for 2022 entry**

The interviews are now all complete for nursing and midwifery and we are processing all the scores from them. Admissions will be making offers via UCAS by 19th May, which is the UCAS deadline. Successful applicants will then be invited to an online offer holders' event when they can find out everything they need to know, meet staff and students and ask questions. We would encourage everyone who is invited to attend, as it really helps candidates who have more than one offer to make decisions; it also really helps students find out what life as a nursing or midwifery student at Queen's is really like.

### **2022 entry to Dentistry**

As in previous years Dentistry has 45 places for home applicants. The admissions team sent out offers for places in April. As we receive replies to these offers Dentistry will continue to give out as many offers as possible until the UCAS decision deadline (19th May 2022). All offers are given in rank order after interview.

As is our normal practice this rank order will also be used for offers should places become available in August/September. At that stage, those applicants who have fulfilled the entry requirements will be reconsidered on the basis of their interview ranking, provided they are not holding a firm or insurance offer with another Dental School through UCAS. As vacancies become available, the next eligible applicant will be offered the place, so it will not be necessary for candidates to contact us. Please note that, at this stage, we cannot predict how many places, if any, become available in August/September.
