




WELCOME TO QUEEN'S UNIVERSITY BELFAST

Queen's University Belfast was founded by Royal Charter in 1845, the 9th oldest university in the UK. A world-leading university celebrating a 180 year history, it has a unique past and a vibrant academic environment. As a centre of excellence,

Queen's has been awarded the Queen's Anniversary Prize seven times, one of the highest honours awarded to higher and further education institutions in the UK. Queen's is also a proud member of the Russell Group and one of the leading universities in the UK providing world-class education underpinned by world-class research.

Postgraduate Entry Requirements

Entry to graduate diploma or taught Masters programmes usually requires either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree.

For most courses, your major subject or content of your Bachelor's degree may also be considered.

The comparable US qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

Bachelor degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.2.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

Bachelor degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.8.

Please note the following key differences between graduate studies in the US and a taught Master's degree at Queen's:

- Master's degrees in the UK are normally one-year in duration.
- There is no GRE or GMAT required for entry to Queen's.

Queen's University Belfast offers up to £16,500 in scholarships for North American students

North America PG Housing Scholarships

The University is pleased to offer 7 full 1 year housing scholarships to postgraduate applicants. These scholarships will cover your housing for 51 weeks in a private en-suite room in Belfast City Centre(Elms BT1).

International Postgraduate Scholarships

For new students studying full-time postgraduate taught programmes. Exclusions apply.
Scholarship Value: £2000 - £5000

Queen's Business School Awards

Applicants from North America studying postgraduate taught programmes at Queen's Business School in 2025/26. Scholarship Value: £6000

LLB Law Senior Status Scholarship

For your first year of study when enrolling on LLB Law Senior Status. Students enrolling Autumn 2025 will be automatically assessed for the LLB Law Senior Status Scholarship award. Scholarship Value: £4000

Early Confirmation Award

New international students with unconditional offers for the academic year 2025/26 may receive a discount of £1500 when paying their tuition fees in full* by the appropriate deadline. Scholarship Value: £1500

Hillary Rodham Clinton Award for Peace & Reconciliation

For one exceptional US student who identifies as female. This award can be applied to one of five Masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast and includes a full tuition fee waiver.

Queen's Loyalty Scholarship

20% Fee Reduction in tuition fees for alumni returning to an eligible programme at Queen's University Belfast. Available to eligible international students returning to study on a full time postgraduate taught or postgraduate research programme.

Vice Chancellor's International Attainment Scholarship

Four exceptional new postgraduate international students enrolling on one of the specified full-time postgraduate taught programmes will receive this prestigious award, of 50% of tuition fees paid for up to a maximum of two year.


