Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

Generally, applicants for undergraduate (Bachelors) degree programmes should hold one of the following qualifications, in addition to a recognised Foundation Programme, for example the INTO Queen's <u>International Foundation</u> <u>Programme</u>:

- A good Certificade de Ensino Médio with high grades
- Diploma de Tecnico de Nivel Medio with high grades
- High grades in the Concurso Vestibular
- Certificado de Conclusao de Segundo Grau with high grades

Applicants with the following will also be considered for entry:

- Successful completion of the first year of a Brazilian University degree
- 3 UK A Levels or
- Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma <u>Information on required grades</u>.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. <u>Course Finder</u>

The comparable Brazilian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

A 4 year Bachelor degree (Bacharel/Licenciado/Professional Title) with an overall mark of 7.5 on a 10 point scale (where the pass mark is 5).

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

A 4 year Bachelor degree (Bacharel/Licenciado/Professional Title) with an overall mark of 6.5 on a 10 point scale (where the pass mark is 5).
