



QUB Admission Requirements Brunei

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ GCE A Levels (University of Cambridge International Exams) taken in Brunei.
- ▶ Recognised Foundation courses taken in the UK, Australia and Canada
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB). Information on required grades.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Bruneian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ Bachelor (Honours) degree 2:1.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ Bachelor (Honours) degree 2:2.

English Language Requirements:

- ▶ Many iGCSE syllabi in English language are accepted
- ▶ O-Level English 1120 syllabus with a minimum of C (with a pass in the oral test) accepted for most programmes.
