^{*} Where Mathematics is a course requirement both the Compulsory and Extended parts will be required, and may be offered in lieu of one of three elective subjects. If Grade A at A-level Mathematics is a course requirement, then Grade 5* in the HKDSE Compulsory part and Grade 5 in the Extended part would be required. If Grade B at A-level is specified, then a minimum of Grade 5 in the Compulsory part and Grade 4 in the Extended part would be required. Where the Mathematics results are higher, some flexibility may be exercised in terms of the grades required in the elective subjects.

- Higher level diplomas and Associate degrees can be considered for entry into year one. A typical requirement would be an average grade of B (70-79%) or a GPA of 3.0 in a relevant subject.
- We will also consider Higher Level Diplomas and Associate degrees for year 2 entry on a case-by-case basis.

English Language Requirements:

- ► HKCEE Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination in English Language. A minimum of Grade 3 in all test elements for most courses
- ► IELTS or an equivalent acceptable qualification: English Language Requirements
