QUB Admission Requirements Indonesia



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- Applicants who have completed the Surat Tanda Tamat Belajar Sekolah Menengah Umum Tingkat Atas (STTB - SMA) with good grades, plus a recognised Foundation Programme are eligible to be considered for entry to undergraduate degree programmes.
- SMU II High School students with a GPA of 7.2+ can undertake the month Foundation Course at INTO Queen's upon satisfactory completion of which leads to Stage 1 of an undergraduate degree.
- SMU III High School students with a GPA of 7.5+ can undertake our 9 month Diploma course at INTO Queen's upon satisfactory completion of which leads to Stage 2 of an undergraduate degree in Management/Finance or Engineering.
- Applicants holding the Diploma D2 (or higher) with very high grades may be considered for entry to Stage 1 of undergraduate programmes.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. <u>Course Finder</u>

The comparable Indonesian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

Sarjana (S1) four-year course with a GPA of at least 3.0/4.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

Sarjana (S1) four-year course with a GPA of at least 2.8/4.

English Language Requirements:

- O-Level English 1123 syllabus with a minimum of C accepted for most programmes.
- Many iGCSE & O-Level syllabi in English language are accepted
- IELTS or an equivalent acceptable qualification: English Langua Requirements
