QUB Admission Requirements Iran



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- The High School Diploma with good grades, plus a recognised Foundation programme.
- The Pre-University Certificate (Peeshdaneshgahe) and achieved grades of at least 14/20 (including relevant subjects).
- Applicants who have completed one or two years of university study may also be eligible, if relevant subjects have been studied and strong grades achieved.
- ▶ 3 UK A Levels.
- Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. <u>Course Finder</u>

The comparable Iranian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

A good Bachelor degree (Licence or Karshenasi), with a grade of 15/20 from a recognised State or Public (including Islamic Azad Universities) and 16/20 from a recognised Private university.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

A good Bachelor degree (Licence or Karshenasi), with a grade of 13/20 from a recognised State or Public (including Islamic Azad Universities) and 14/20 from a recognised Private university.
