QUB Admission Requirements Jordan



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ► Tawjihi (General Secondary Education Certificate) with good grades and a recognised Foundation/bridging qualification.
- Holders of the Al-Shamel Intermediate Diploma may be considered on a case by case basis.
- Applicants who have successfully completed the first year of a Jordanian University degree with good grades in relevant subjects may be considered for admission to the first year of undergraduate degree programmes.
- A Levels.
- Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. Course Finder

The comparable Jordanian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

▶ A four-year Bachelor degree awarded by a recognised University, with an average of 70% or GPA 3.0/4.0.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

A four-year Bachelor degree awarded by a recognised University, with an average of 65% or GPA 2.8/4.0.

English Language Requirements:

► IELTS or an equivalent acceptable qualification: English Langua Requirements
