

# QUB Admission Requirements Jordan



## Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ Tawjihi (General Secondary Education Certificate) with good grades and a recognised Foundation/bridging qualification.
- ▶ Holders of the Al-Shamel Intermediate Diploma may be considered on a case by case basis.
- ▶ Applicants who have successfully completed the first year of a Jordanian University degree with good grades in relevant subjects may be considered for admission to the first year of undergraduate degree programmes.
- ▶ A Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

## Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Jordanian qualifications are as follows:

### UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A four-year Bachelor degree awarded by a recognised University, with an average of 70% or GPA 3.0/4.0.

### UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A four-year Bachelor degree awarded by a recognised University, with an average of 65% or GPA 2.8/4.0.
