Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- The Shahadat-al-thanawia-al-a'ama (General Secondary School Certificate) with a score of 80% plus a recognised Foundation programme.
- ► The American High School Diploma with a CGPA of 3.2/4.0 plus a recognised Foundation programme (if no APs or SAT lis are taken).
- Applicants who have successfully completed the first year of a Kuwaiti University degree with good grades in relevant subjects may be considered for admission to the first year of an undergraduate programme.
- Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. Course Finder

The comparable Kuwaiti qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

▶ A Bachelor degree from a recognised university with grade B or 3.0/4 or 3.75/5 or 'Very Good'.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

► A Bachelor degree from a recognised university with grade B- or 2.67/4 or 3.3/5 or 'Good'.

English Language Requirements:

► IELTS or an equivalent acceptable qualification: English Langua Requirements
