QUB Admission Requirements Libya



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ► The Secondary Education Certificate with good grades, plus a recognised Foundation programme.
- Applicants who have completed the first year of a Bachelor degree at a recognised Libyan university with good grades in relevant subjects will be considered for admission to the first year of undergraduate degree programmes.
- ▶ 3 UK A Levels.
- Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. Course Finder

The comparable Libyan qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

A four-year Bachelor degree from a recognised Libyan university with a grade of 70%.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

A four-year Bachelor degree from a recognised Libyan university with grade of 65%.
